RESERVATIONS

A \$300.00 deposit per person is due by December 15, 2010. Also due at that time is a completed and signed reservation form(s) and a copy of the front page of your passport valid until November 1, 2011 or later. Submitting these documents is required and will secure a reservation for the tour.

FINAL PAYMENT

The balance of the tour price is due in full by January 15, 2011. Payment may be made by check, Visa or Master Card payable to Guidelines, Inc., 26076 Getty Drive, Laguna Niguel, CA 92677. Payments made by charge card will incur an additional 5% surcharge. Payments received after January 15, 2011 are subject to possible cancellation of related reservation(s).

CANCELLATIONS REFUNDS & LATE BOOKING

Cancellations must be made in writing to Guidelines, Inc., 26076 Getty Drive, Laguna Niguel, CA 92677. The following amounts will be deducted from any refund due based on the date of receipt of cancellation by Pilgrim Tours.

- 100+ days prior to tour date \$100.00 per person
- 99-61 days prior to tour date Deposit Amount (\$300.00)
- 60-46 days prior to tour date 40% of tour cost
- 45-31 days prior to tour date 65% of tour cost
- 30-16 days prior to tour date 85% of tour cost

Late Bookings: Reservations received within 45 days of tour departure date are subject to a \$100.00 per person surcharge; additionally, expenses related to special or overnight postal delivery of tour documents and/or information to tour members will be passed on to those travelers.

PRICING

Quoted tour prices of \$3,450.00 round trip from Los Angeles are per person double occupancy and include: planning, handling and operational charges and are based on the current rate of exchange and tariffs. (Price round trip from other US locations will vary according to location.) In the event of a marked change in foreign exchange rates, fuel costs or tariff rates, tour costs are subject to revision. Such increases will be added to your final billing. Pilgrim Tours & Guidelines, Inc. reserve the right to vary itineraries and prices, and to substitute facilities and hotels of equal or better quality if necessary.

SINGLE SUPPLEMENT

An additional single supplement charge of \$659.00 will be charged for travelers not wishing to share a room.

INCLUDED IN TOUR PRICE

Quoted tour price of \$3,450.00 round trip from Los Angeles is per person based on double occupancy and includes: Planning, roundtrip airfare from Los Angeles, California to Tel Aviv, Israel, air taxes & fuel surcharges, 8 nights lodging at first class hotels, breakfast and dinner daily, full time English speaking tour guide, tour transportation by air conditioned deluxe motor coach as appears on the itinerary, all guides, entrance fees, touring and other transportation as appear in the itinerary, baggage handling at hotels (one bag per traveler), and tips to tour guide and driver.

NOT INCLUDED IN TOUR PRICE

Tips other than mentioned above (hotel staff, airline staff, waiters, etc.), lunches, optional travel insurance, optional fee for payment by credit card (additional 5% of the total bill), personal items including but not limited to phone calls, valet laundry service, beverages when not included with meals, additional tips, charges for baggage, medical treatment and other items of a personal nature. **NOTE:** Various fees are not included in pricing by the airline such as security fees, departure taxes and baggage check in. AIRLINE SECURITY

PROOF OF US CITIZENSHIP, PASSPORT, VISA & MINOR CHILDREN REQUIREMENTS

Minors traveling with either one parent or no parents must have a certified letter of permission from the parent or parents who is/are not traveling. This letter must be presented at airport check-in. All international tours require a current passport. Entrance to Israel requires your passport be valid for at least 6 months after your return date. A copy of your passport photo page reflecting your passport number, place of issuance, and expiration date must accompany each reservation form and deposit. Photocopies are not acceptable forms of identification during actual travel. Non U. S. Citizens are responsible to fulfill appropriate entry requirements of the destination country. Contact the Israeli Consulate for information.

TOUR MEMBERSHIP

Tour membership is available to all travelers and will not be withheld if the tour operator can furnish special requirements that an individual may need. 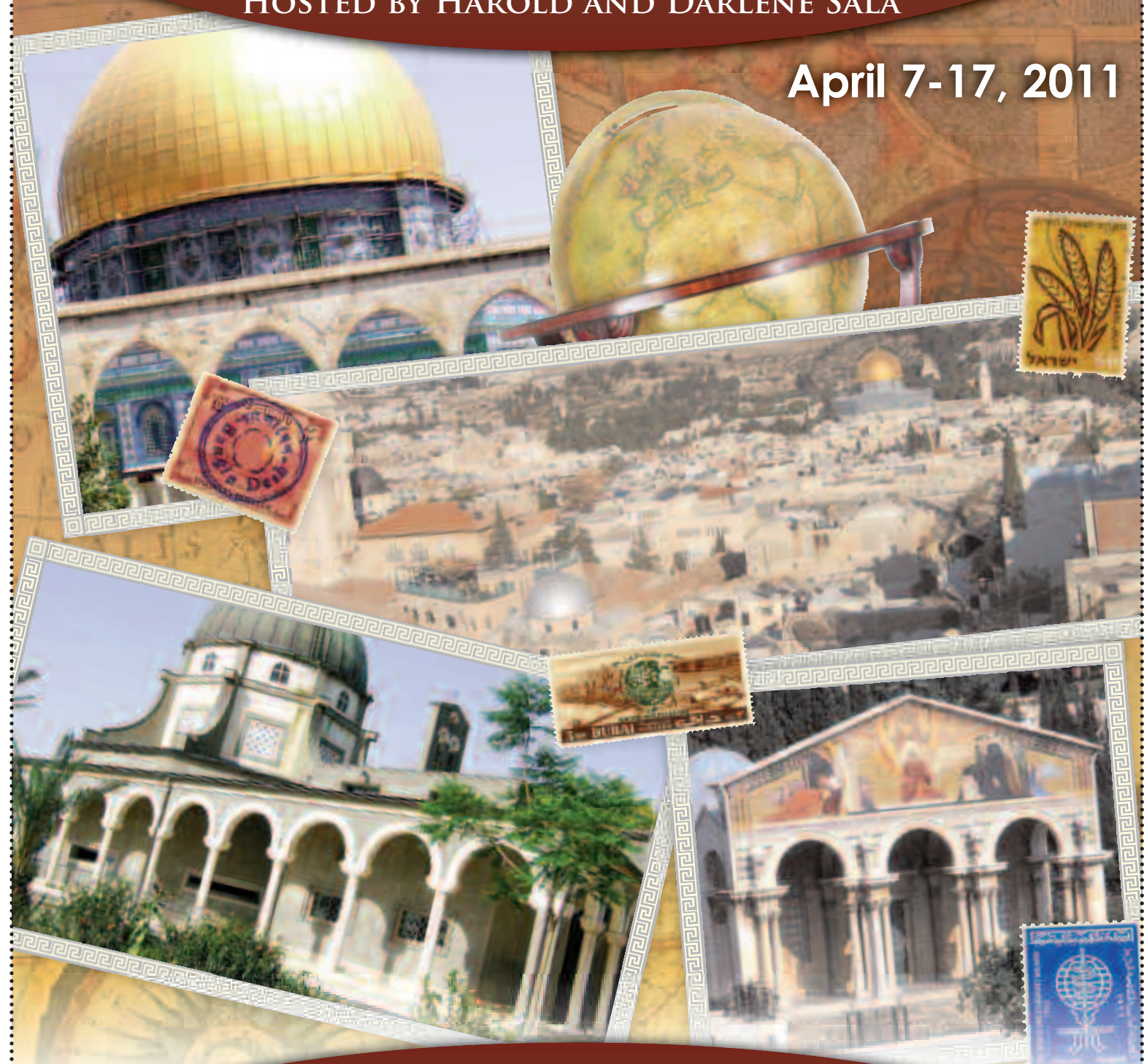

Thursday, Apr 7, 2011

We depart from the U.S. for Israel and arrive the following day.

Friday, Apr 8, 2011

We clear customs and are overnight at our hotel which begins your Israel experience.

Hotel: Dan Panorama

Saturday, Apr. 9: Caesarea and Northern Israel

We drive north today to Caesarea to view the ruins of the Hippodrome, The ruins of the Crusader's fortress, and moat and sit in the great Roman amphitheater. Continuing along the coast, you will see the aqueduct that carried water from Mt. Carmel to Caesarea. Lunch at Mt. Carmel. Then we then drive on to Megiddo located on the Plain of Esdraelon where Armageddon will take place. In the afternoon we drive by Nain and Hazor. We will proceed to our hotel for dinner and overnight.

Hotel: Nof Ginosar Kibbutz Hotel

Sunday, Apr. 10: Northern Galilee

Today we drive to the most northern point of ancient Israel--Dan

and view the Nature Reserve, the ancient city of Dan (with the altar of Jeroboam) and Caesarea Philippi where Jesus asked Peter, "Whom do you say that I am?" Late afternoon we drive across the Golan Heights and visit the Jordan River and the baptismal site (you can be baptized here if you so desire). We then proceed to our Kibbutz hotel overlooking beautiful Galilee.

Hotel: Nof Ginosar Kibbutz Hotel

Monday, Apr. 11: Galilee

Begin the day visiting the nearby museum where "The Jesus boat" is on display. Next stop is the ancient church on the eastern shores of Galilee where the Maniac of Gadara was delivered, Then we drive around the

northern end of Galilee to Capernaum, where Jesus healed Peter's mother-in-law. The ruins of the synagogue are outstanding. We pass the ruins of cities that played prominent parts in Jesus' ministry--Tabghah, Corazin, Kursi, and then to the Mt. of Beatitudes (Sermon on the Mount). Then we cross Galilee by boat and enjoy a complimentary lunch of St. Peter's fish. We return to the hotel in time to enjoy a swim in Galilee or in the resort pool.

Hotel: Nof Ginosar Kibbutz Hotel

Tuesday, Apr. 12: Jordan Valley / Jerusalem

Today we leave after breakfast, motoring down the Jordan Valley (The ancient King's Highway) where the once desert now blossoms as a rose. We proceed past the ruins of Bet Shan for an unforgettable visit to Masada, the home of the Jewish defenders who held out against the 10th Roman Legion for three years but capitulated in 73 AD, taking their lives rather than be captured. After lunch we visit Qumran, the site of Essenes, who were responsible for preserving thousands of scrolls and fragments of Scripture. Then we proceed on to the Dead Sea. After a float in the water (you cannot sink), we are on our way to Jerusalem, passing through the valley which may well be the setting of Psalm 23, past the Inn of the Good Samaritan. On to our hotel in Jerusalem.

Hotel: Jerusalem Olive Tree in Jerusalem

Wednesday, Apr. 13: Walking Tour of Jerusalem

We begin the morning with an in-depth tour of the four quarters of Jerusalem.



of the upper room which Jesus may have used in celebrating the Passover), we visit the lovely Garden Tomb (site of Gordon's Calvary) where we reflect on the momentous events in the life of Jesus and observe communion.

Hotel: Jerusalem Olive Tree in Jerusalem

Thursday, Apr. 14: Jerusalem, Day 2

Today we visit the Temple Mount (Dome of the Rock) and the Western Wall of the Temple and an unforgettable trip through the Rabbi's Tunnel under the old Temple area.. Then on to the Mount of Olives and the Garden of Gethsemane. We proceed to St. Peter's in Gallicantu (the home of Caiaphas, the high priest).

In the afternoon we visit the Yad VaShem memorial to the 6 million Jews who were killed in the Holocaust.

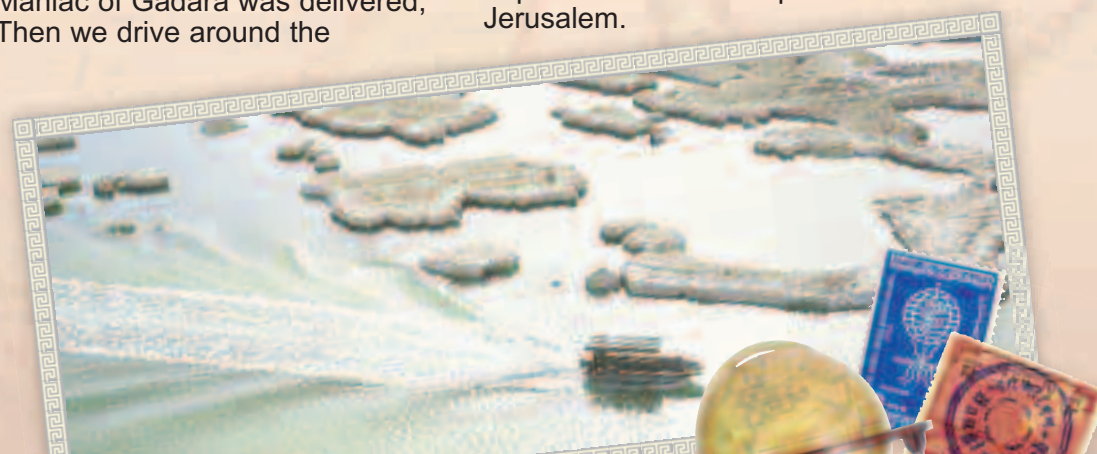
Hotel: Jerusalem Olive Tree in Jerusalem

Friday, Apr. 15: Jerusalem, Day 3

This morning we visit Mt. Zion, the home of David mentioned so often in the Psalms. Then on to the model depicting how Jerusalem looked in the first century (adjacent to the Shrine of the Book where you see a replica of the Isaiah scroll with other important manuscripts from the Dead Sea Scroll collection (from Qumran which you will have seen).

Afternoon is optional for shopping in Ben Yehuda Street, or the old Jaffa Gate. On your own

Our first stop is the historic Church of the Holy Sepulchre (probably the site of the crucifixion and the tomb of Joseph of Arimathea). We visit Mt. Zion, the home of David mentioned so often in the Psalms We walk through the streets of the Old City along the Via Dolorosa, visiting some of the sites that played such a prominent part in the passion of Jesus. Visit the Antonia, Ecce Homo, Church of St. Anne, and the Pool of Bethesda. After a visit to the Upper Room (12th century but on the site



proceed through Hezekiah's tunnel or back to the hotel for rest before an dinner On your own you can shop or visit the Bible society.

Hotel: Jerusalem Olive Tree in Jerusalem

Saturday, Apr. 16: Ein Gedi, Shepherd's Fields and The Passover

In the morning we go by bus to Ein Gedi, some 10 miles from Jerusalem. On our return we visit Shepherd's Fields opposite Bethlehem. In the afternoon we climax our visit to Israel as we focus on the Passover, enjoying a re-enactment of the tradition in a Christian context. We then drive to Tel Aviv and catch a late night flight back to the U.S.

Sunday, Apr. 17:

We say Shalom to Israel/Home in the U.S.
